

# International Plan Checklist

This is a self-audit tool that students can use to track their progress through the various IP components.

# I. Globally-Oriented Coursework:

All IP students complete one course in each of three categories: International Relations, Global Economics, and one course focused on the country/region of the student's overseas experiences. The complete list of IP – approved courses is available in the GT catalog at: <a href="http://www.catalog.gatech.edu/specialacademic/international.php">http://www.catalog.gatech.edu/specialacademic/international.php</a>. (*List is subject to change*.) Students can also request to use courses taken on an exchange program by petitioning the IP Committee.

Ideally, the IP global courses will fulfill a student's social science, humanities, or ethics requirements whenever possible. Ask your academic unit advisor or IP faculty representative for guidance when making these decisions.

#### Please note:

- AP credits may not be used to fulfill IP course requirements
- All three courses must be taken for a letter grade unless only offered as pass/fail
- Only one 1000-level course may be used to satisfy the globally-focused courses

### II. Language Requirement:

All IP students must develop proficiency in a language other than English through the 2002-level or equivalent. Equivalency may be demonstrated by taking a placement test, scoring a 4 or better on the AP exam, Oral Proficiency exam, or another method as determined by the GT School of Modern Languages.

- a. Languages used for purposes of the IP should fit with the overall plan of each student.
  - i. If language(s) of host country(ies) is a language that is taught at GT, the chosen IP language should be coherent with one of the locations.
  - ii. If language(s) of host country(ies) is not taught at GT or is English, students can use any language to fulfill the IP requirement.
- b. Students wishing to demonstrate a higher level of proficiency have the option to take the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) administered by ACTFL. Students who pass the OPI at the requisite level of proficiency receive a "Language Proficiency" designation in addition to the regular International Plan designation.

# III. International Experience:

Students must complete **within two terms** a minimum of 26 weeks of active engagement abroad (i.e. full-time studying, working, and/or researching) on Georgia Tech-sponsored programs. The experiences abroad must involve living among and being actively engaged in the local academic, research, or work community abroad. The terms of experience do not have to be consecutive and may occur in different countries. **Only one term may be a summer.** 

The defining characteristic of the international experiences should be *coherence*. In other words, the international experiences should take place in locations that share a common language, or in countries/programs which offer the opportunity to delve deeply into a specific aspect of one's major (e.g. intellectually coherent). For the international experience, IP students will:

- be enrolled at Georgia Tech while completing the IP international experience/s
- complete and submit the "International Experiences Approval Form" prior to departing the US
- meet the minimum GPA requirement of their program abroad
